We hope you all enjoyed the Mother's Day Tea as much as we did! Thank you all for helping with the menu and making it a special day for the kids, too.

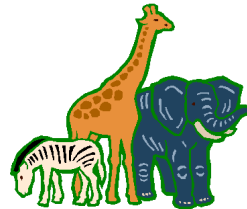
Can you believe we just have a few weeks left before summer break? Yikes! We have lots of fun activities packed into these weeks, but also lots of work to finish up.
